

206.080 Officers not to charge fee for collecting pensions -- Attorney's fee.

- (1) No officer of the state or county, except notaries public, shall charge an official fee for services in connection with the prosecution or collection of pension.
- (2) No person shall charge, demand or receive more than five dollars (\$5) for his services as agent or attorney in prosecuting any claim for a pension.
