

95.630 Group life insurance, police and fire departments.

- (1) The legislative bodies of cities of the second and third classes or urban-county governments may, by ordinance, form the members of the police and fire departments into groups to obtain the advantages of the group plan of life insurance.
- (2) The legislative bodies may aid the members of the police and fire departments by paying from city funds not to exceed fifty percent (50%) of the annual premiums on the policies, and may contract with the insurer on such other terms as may be provided for in the ordinance.
