

206.030 Persons ineligible for pension.

No person shall be entitled to the benefits of this chapter who:

- (1) Is able to earn a support by manual labor or by reason of his knowledge, art or skill in any profession, trade or craft;
- (2) Removes from this state or is absent therefrom for a period of three (3) months;
- (3) Possesses property of the value of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500);
- (4) Possesses an income to the amount of or equivalent to three hundred dollars (\$300) a year; or who is living with his spouse who possesses property in fee simple or a life interest of the value of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500), or an income of three hundred dollars (\$300) per year;
- (5) Is suitably provided with support by reason of a contract or agreement with a person able to provide such support; or
- (6) By reason of combined partial ability to earn a support and income and property, or any and all of these combined is able to obtain an income equivalent to three hundred dollars (\$300) a year. Provided, however, that no pension received from the United States or any state or foreign government or any other source shall be figured in the computation of income under this chapter.
