244.600 Commercial bribery unlawful.

No brewer shall induce through any of the following means, any malt beverage retailer to purchase any malt beverage products from him to the exclusion in whole or in part of malt beverages sold or offered for sale by other persons, if the brewer engages in the practice of using such means, or any of them, to such an extent as substantially to restrain or prevent transactions in malt beverages:

- (1) By commercial bribery; or
- (2) By offering or giving any bonus, premium or compensation to any officer, employee or representative of the retailer; or
- (3) By making or allowing any rebates or refunds to any officer, employee or representative of the retailer.
