

271B.15-320 Appeal from revocation. (Repealed, effective January 1, 2011)

- (1) A foreign corporation may appeal the Secretary of State's revocation of its certificate of authority to the Franklin Circuit Court within thirty (30) days after service of the certificate of revocation. The foreign corporation may appeal by petitioning the court to set aside the revocation and attaching to the petition copies of its certificate of authority and the Secretary of State's certificate of revocation.
- (2) The court may summarily order the Secretary of State to reinstate the certificate of authority or may take any other action the court considers appropriate.
- (3) The court's final decision may be appealed as in other civil proceedings.
