317A.100 Reciprocal licensing.

- (1) The cosmetologist board may prescribe reasonable rules and regulations pertaining to the issuance of a license, upon payment of the prescribed license fee, to any person holding a comparable license issued by another state where the laws of such state, in the opinion of the cosmetologist board, provide comparable professional qualification, health and safety standards;
- (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1) of this section, a license to operate or practice in this state may be refused or denied a holder of a license issued by another state if such state does not extend to the holder of a Kentucky license similar or comparable recognition and opportunity.
