

218A.1454 Possession of substituted cathinones -- Penalty.

- (1) A person is guilty of possession of naphthylpyrovalerone, 3,4-methylenedioxypropylvalerone, 3,4-methylenedioxypropylmethylcathinone, or 4-methylmethcathinone when he or she knowingly and unlawfully possesses naphthylpyrovalerone, 3,4-methylenedioxypropylvalerone, 3,4-methylenedioxypropylmethylcathinone, or 4-methylmethcathinone.
- (2) Possession of naphthylpyrovalerone, 3,4-methylenedioxypropylvalerone, 3,4-methylenedioxypropylmethylcathinone, or 4-methylmethcathinone is a Class B misdemeanor, except that, KRS Chapter 532 to the contrary notwithstanding, the maximum term of incarceration shall be no greater than thirty (30) days.
