242.220 Refund of license money when prohibition goes into effect.

After prohibition goes into effect, no license formerly issued in that territory shall be valid, but the licensee shall be entitled to recover from the county or city to which the license money was paid, a part of the license money proportionate to the unexpired period of the license.
