317B.015 Prohibited activities -- Applicability of KRS 317B.010 to 317B.060.

- (1) Estheticians practicing under KRS 317B.010 to 317B.060 shall not perform any of the following: Botox or collagen injections, laser treatments, electrolysis, tattoo, permanent makeup, microdermabrasion, or piercing unless practicing under the immediate supervision of a licensed physician.
- (2) The provisions of KRS 317B.010 to 317B.060 shall not apply to any other person licensed, certified, or registered under any other chapter of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, or any student within an accredited training program of any of these professions. Nothing in KRS 317B.010 to 317B.060 shall be construed to limit, interfere, or restrict the practice, descriptions of services, or manner in which that person holds himself or herself out to the public so long as that person does not hold himself or herself out as an esthetician unless that person is licensed as an esthetician under KRS 317B.010 to 317B.060.
